OBJECTIVES OF THE PROJECT

EMIRE will develop concepts and instruments that support the empowerment process, promote a positive perception of women on the labor market and help women to participate in the integration process.

- 2. Social workers, (employment) consultants and volunteers** who work with adult female migrants and accompany them in the integration process.
