## the project

Plai(i)n VET is an Erasmus+ funded “Strategic Partnership for Cooperation in VET Training” project that aims to support young learners with special needs in the transition period between school and the entry to labour market. To do so, partners are creating an assessment tool to empower young learners to decide their own path within the VET system and allowing professional self-realization. This assessment tool is written in Plain Language to facilitate their understanding and will be supported by videos. The content of this first result of the project is already finished in English and in Spanish, Greek, German and Swedish. Official proof readings are currently being held in all the languages. The readings are being carried out by experts and by young students with special needs so that accessibility and understanding are granted. Plai(i)nVET relies on the fact that overcoming language barriers is essential for an inclusive strategy in VET.

The partner consortium met in Graz, on the 7<sup>th</sup> of November hosted by InterAktion. During the meeting, partners had the chance to catch up and discuss about the Assessment Tool that was developed under PR1 and its finalized version after the testing in the LTTA that took place in Sweden. Furthermore, partners had the chance to discuss about the supporting videos of the Assessment Tool and the developments around PR2. Since the project approaches its completion, partners were able to reflect on the work done, the impact of the project and future plans to sustain the results of the project. Face to face meetings always give the consortium the chance to connect and exchange thoughts and ideas which would not be possible to cover during digital meetings. The meeting in Graz offered the partners the opportunity to engage in meaningful discussions and also visit the beautiful city of Graz and get a taste of the local cuisine.

The project's Learning Teaching Training took place between the 9<sup>th</sup> and 11<sup>th</sup> of May in Örkelljunga, Sweden. Surrounded by a beautiful and peaceful green scenery, VET teachers, labour market consultants and trainers from the partner countries, had the chance to test the assessment tool developed by the consortium and offer their professional feedback on how to improve it. The participants of the training were all professionals who are working with people with disabilities and their input was valuable in understanding the needs of the target group regarding the use of Plain Language.

The partners are currently working on PR2 *Let's realise inclusion together* which consists of a series of short videos with inclusive companies and their trainees with special needs sharing good practice examples.
