Pla(i)n VET is an Erasmus+ funded “Strategic Partnership for Cooperation in VET Training” project that aims to support young learners with special needs in the transition period between school and the entry to labour market. Pla(i)nVET relies on the fact that overcoming language barriers is essential for an inclusive strategy in VET.

After the last transnational partner meeting in Austria in winter 2023, the partners continued their final works on the project distant from each other.
