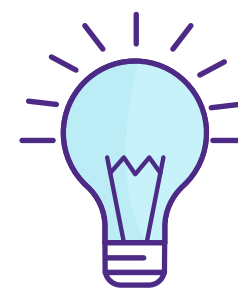
2. Short video interviews with inclusive companies and their trainees with special needs.



Plain Language is easier to understand.

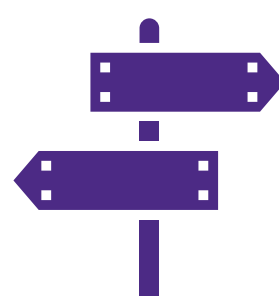
Plain Language is important for people with intellectual disabilities, so they can:
