Keeping up our PROMISE...

We are keeping up our PROMISE... The project titled as ***Promoting Refugee and Migrant Integration through Education (PROMISE)*** is an EU Erasmus+ project bringing together project partners and experts from Ireland, Turkey, the United Kingdom, Germany, Spain and Italy.

The project has been implemented within the framework of Erasmus+ KA2 Strategic Partnerships for Adult Education. It is co-funded by European Commission. This project aims to **facilitate the optimal integration of refugees and migrants into their host communities so that both the host and the migrant can flourish in their new situation.**

The **dissemination activities** have been implemented by each partner at local, national and international level since the beginning of the project (1st October 2018).

The partners have implemented the dissemination activities as set in the Dissemination Plan which was composed by Tuzla Kaymakamligi, the dissemination lead partner. Dissemination is carried out differently in each city, since each application partner elaborates its own local dissemination plan, describing its own strategies and tools.

These local plans are based on the overall dissemination strategy described throughout the Dissemination Plan. This way, dissemination at project-level will adapt and contribute to the overall dissemination strategy of PROMISE.



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Building up our interagency networks

PROMISE partners are building up **interagency networks** enabling organizations in host communities to better plan their support structures and training activities in coordination with other actors in the partners' regions; Roscommon - Ireland, Tuzla/Istanbul - Turkey, Kiel - Germany, San Sebastian - Spain, Perugia - Italy.



Developing social inclusion toolkit

The PROMISE partnership has developed “**Social Inclusion Toolkit**” presenting **best practice** from across the EU which educators can replicate or adapt in their own communities. Approaches have been organized thematically – employment & education, civic life & culture, well-being & family.



The objective of this PROMISE Social Inclusion Toolkit is to raise the awareness of educators, organizations and stakeholders of the most effective approaches to competence development in intercultural adult education.

We have sought out and now share good practice in the provision of learning opportunities for refugees and recently arrived migrants.

Cooperating partners

The partners gathered together twice after the kick off meeting in **Roscommon, Ireland** on 30th and 31st October 2018 hosted by the project coordinator, **Roscommon Leader Partnership (RLP)**.

On 16-17 May 2019, the partners met in **Kiel, Germany** with the host of **Kultur Life** in order to discuss about the project progress, to identify tasks, methods and strategies for developing the action plan in order to address the intellectual outputs and activities in the following months.



The third project meeting was held on **13-14 November 2019** in **San Sebastian, Spain** hosted by **CEBANC**.

The partners mainly discussed about developing **O3: OER's for Service Providers** and **O4: Online Resources for Refugees and Migrants**.



They also planned “**Skills Accelerator**” **learning activity** which will take place in Perugia, Italy between 20-24 April 2020.
